The mission of the University of Tennessee Health Science Center is to bring the benefits of the health sciences to the achievement and maintenance of human health, with a focus on the citizens of Tennessee and the region, by pursuing an integrated program of education, research, clinical care, and public service.

Each of the professional programs offered at the UTHSC pursues the mission of the institution by producing caring, competent, and ethical patient-focused healthcare professionals prepared to detect, treat and prevent human disease and injury, as well as provide guidance in the achievement and maintenance of human health. The expectation is that every student in each professional program will pass the appropriate licensure examination at or near completion of the program. Similarly, students enrolled in the College of Graduate Health Sciences are expected to complete their studies in a timely manner in their pursuit of being noted scientists in health-related fields of research.

The UTHSC measures student achievement in a number of ways. Basic information about enrollment, degrees conferred by program, and the diversity of the student body can be found in the institutional Fact Book. However, the primary measures of student achievement utilized by the UTHSC are the first time pass rates on the various licensure exams.
