- Minutes of 10/17/17 were approved unanimously
 - Committee Reports
 - Handbook Committee- The Handbook committee is working on the external letters for tenure policy and deciding on important elements. The committee met with AFSA and collected similar policies from peer institutions. They will evaluate and develop a draft.
 - o BOT Report Terry Cooper
 - The free speech policy was adopted. It mirrors state law.
 - The uniform administrative procedures policy was also adopted. The policy concerns how contested cases for termination are determined.
 - 3 UTHSC faculty members received expedited tenure.
 - The Knoxville football stadium will undergo a major renovation.
 - The UT-owned farm that is part of the Agriculture Institute will become a meeting center (it will still be a working farm).
 - The UTHSC came out best in outsourcing. Other campuses elected not to outsource. We were already outsourcing all of the trades and will move forward in cooperation with the University of Memphis.
 - Tenure and evaluation of tenure decisions did not generate much feedback. This will be discussed at the December and March BOT meetings. Please give

feedback. Joe DiPietro sent out a survey about tenure issues- please complete the survey.

- New Business
 - TUFS constitution action item
 - The Tennessee University Faculty Senates recently revised its constitution. The UTHSC Faculty Senate Executive Committee had some reservations about use of the word 'cohort' (group with similar characteristics), as this leaves open possibility of a small group making decisions. The FSEC wants the word changed to 'membership' to ensure equal representation.
 - The Senate approved the changes to the TUFS constitution with a vote.
