FY 2025 Governor Budget Proposal


For the UT Health Science Center, Governor Lee has proposed:

- \$6.875 million in recurring funds for salary increases for full-time faculty and staff
- \$2.1 million in recurring funds for health insurance cost increases
- \$716,900 in recurring funds for operating cost increases
- \$6.24 million in one-time funds for capital maintenance project support
- \$18.05 million to support year three of the Healthy Smiles Initiative, aimed at increasing the number of dentists practicing in Tennessee

- System integration testing is wrapping up
- User Acceptance Testing
 - Week of March 18 EPM
 - Week of March 25 Oracle Maintenance
 - Weeks of April 01 and April 08 HR and ERP
- Payroll UAT in April
 - 2 Bi-weekly payroll
 - Monthly payroll
 - Longevity



Dash Update

- UAT user requests have gone out to campus
 - We have received most of the information
- Training will now use Oracle guided learning (OGL) instead of previously decided tool, Maverick
- Identified of training leads has occurred and rollout strategy will be communicated soon

IRIS to DASH Cutover & Blackout Period

- An IRIS to DASH cutover plan has been drafted. Next steps are to review and confirm the details for each by module (e.g., when and how to process salary increases).
- Certain transactions will stop in IRIS over the last two weeks in June, isolated cases may require a longer period. This allows for a staggered conversion of data that aligns to our go-live.
