- Developed two new centers of excellence: Center for Community and Global Partnerships and the Margaret A Newman Center for Nursing Theory
- Enhanced use of technology: Added a faculty workload tracking tool, CRM, and admission management tool, and developed a detailed evaluation plan. Currently placing the data plan into a software system to create dashboards
- Secured resources through philanthropy: first fully funded BSN scholarship for the College, established the second Endowed Chair and second Endowed Professorship in the CON, created a student emergency fund which is now endowed, secured 1.2 million each year for 3 years from local corporations to scholarship students, grew donors from less than 300 to over 530, established 13 new endowed scholarships since 2015 (college previously had 12)
- Grew grant funding from less than \$700,000 in 2015 to over \$2.5 million in 2022
