Elective description:

The elective in pediatric endocrinology is designed to teach residents to evaluate and manage the most common problems of pediatric endocrinology and metabolism including: growth evaluation, puberty, thyroid, adrenal, pituitary and metabolic disorders, in addition to exposure to some of the less common problems. It is also meant to serve as an introduction to the discipline for those who intend to seek further training in general pediatrics or endocrinology. Dr. Al-Zubeidi will meet with the elective residents at the beginning of the endocrine elective for orientation. The residents will participate in the academic exercises of the Division. Each resident/medical student will be expected to present a case at the endocrinology division case conference in the last week of the elective which will usually be on the 4th Wednesday of the month. If residents have other, specific educational goals, the elective may be individualized by prior arrangement to fulfill those.

- 1. Reading material (the reading material will be in PDF format) and is available on shared drive, Sharee will send a copy as well by email.

Description of elective:

- A. Outpatient clinic sessions:
 Goal is to coordinate with other learners so that we don't overlap multiple learners in one clinic
- Adolescent rotation residents: I suggest elective and adolescent resident communicate ahead of time to coordinate this, in the past I have emailed/shared the adolescent rotation calendar with elective residents to coordinate this.
