

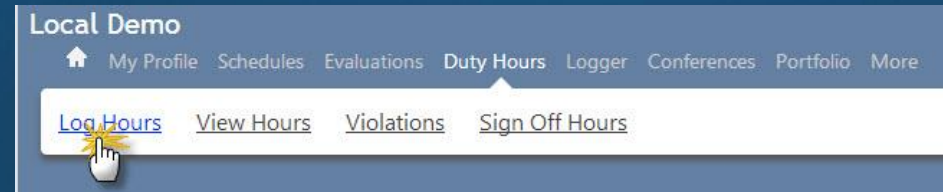
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GME Team

Our Duty Types

1. Call In-House/Overnight
 2. Daytime Call (not overnight)
 3. EM Residents – ED Shift
 4. EM Residents – Weekly Conference
 5. Home Call (Called in)
 6. Home Call (Not called in)
 7. Moonlighting
 8. Night Float
 9. Post Call/Transitions in Duty
 10. Regular Duty Hours
- No scheduled shift should ever be logged or worked longer than 24 hours.
 - You can remain after 24 hours and log it as #9 – Post Call/Transitions in Duty.

LEAVE POLICY

Graduate Medical Education – Chattanooga

Leave Policy – GME Policy # 250

- During each 12 month period of training:
 - Residents are allowed up to 3 weeks paid vacation (15 weekdays and 6 weekend days)
 - Residents are allowed up to 3 weeks paid sick (15 weekdays and 6 weekend days) – personal or family illness, injury
 - Residents (after working for 12 months & 1250 hours) are eligible for up to 12 weeks (3 months) of FMLA – protected unpaid leave (must exhaust paid leave first)
 - TN Parental Leave Act – provides up to 16 weeks (4 months) protected unpaid leave for pregnancy, birth, adoption (must exhaust paid leave first)
 - Maximum family leave available is the 16 weeks provided under the TN Parental Leave Act

Effective July 1, 2022

- In accordance with ACGME Institutional Requirements effective July 1, 2022 (IV.H.1.), the UTCOM Chattanooga GME Leave Policy includes
 - Residents will be eligible to have an additional 6 weeks of paid leave (medical, parental, or caregiver leave) ONE time during their training program
