Expanded Functions for Dental Auxiliary (EFDA) Waiting List & Application Process:

- 1. Complete and Submit an EFDA Course Waiting List Application. You will be placed on your selected EFDA "Course" Restorative or Prosthetic waiting list and be assigned a SEAT. Waiting List Applications are date and time stamped by the CDE Office.
- 2. All potential registrants will receive important course information and the formal application via email only! It will be up to each registrant to complete and return the application from point of receipt.
- 3. A deposit will need to be received by the date listed in the email sent regarding your assigned seat or your seat in the course will be forfeited.
- 4. Your license MUST be valid when submitting the waiting list application and when you receive the official application for the EFDA Course you are assigned to. It is imperative that you have a valid license with the state of Tennessee at all times.
- 5. Dental auxiliary must follow the Tennessee Board of Dentistry rules and have the required years of service and chairside experience. Your dentist must sign off on the official EFDA course application- NOT the waiting list application.

Admission Requirements: Tennessee Board of Dentistry

According to the rules of the Tennessee Board of Dentistry 0460-04-.10 eligibility for this course includes:

Licensed dental hygienists and registered dental assistants who are currently licensed with the Tennessee Board of Dentistry and have a minimum of two (2) years of continuous full-time employment within the past three (3) years in a dental practice as <u>a practicing dental assistant/hygienist</u> are eligible for admission to a Board approved certification course in restorative and/or prosthetic functions. A registered dental assistant must apply for and complete a Board approved certification course in restorative or prosthetic functions and obtain the appropriate certification, issued by the Board, before he/she can perform expanded restorative or prosthetic functions on any patient.
