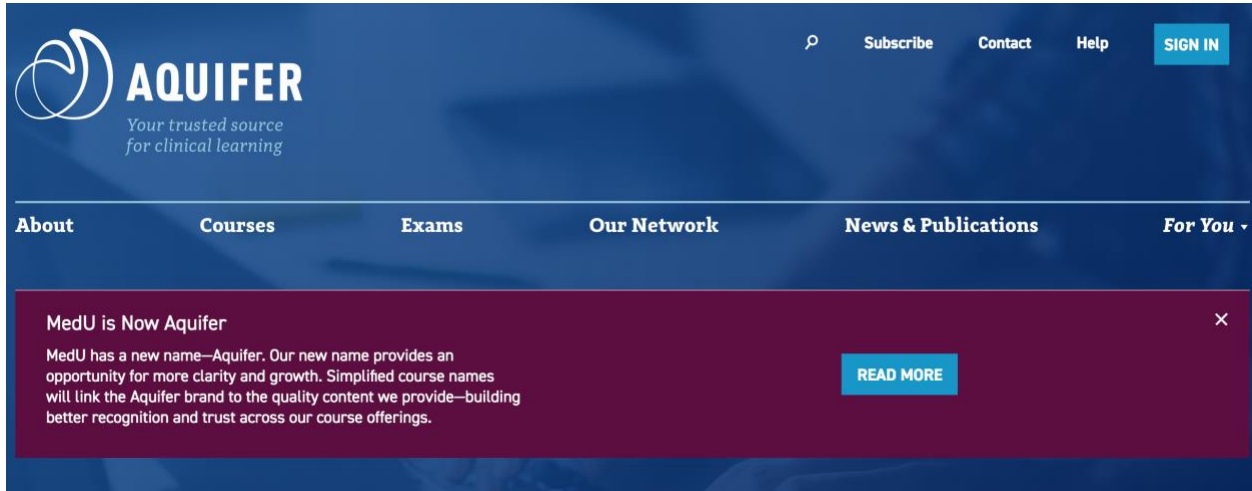


Instructions for Logging onto Aquifer Site

1. Go to the Aquifer website: <https://aquifer.org/>. Click on “Sign In” at the top.

Aquifer Culture in Health Care

Available free of charge.
