


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
Event Mapping Session Objectives

Navigate to Event Screen



Select an event on the calendar to open the Event Screen.

Select Mapping



Click on the **Mapping** tab and select **Map Session Objectives**.

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Adding Objectives



1. Use the **New (Multi)** button to add up to 6 objectives at once
2. Use the **New** button to a one objective

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

3. Click on **Delete Record** on the popup window to delete that objective.

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
Linking Session Objective to a G&O mapping term

Click the number link under the G&O column to begin linking a Session Objective to a G&O mapping term.

Click Goals and Objectives to link



1. Click on **Get Extended List** to get the list of **Available Goals and Objectives**.
2. Click to select the relevant Goals and Objectives, these will then move to the Selected Goals and Objectives column on the right.


Continue to perform this step for each session objective in the list.

To de-select a selected G&O, click the link to move it back to the Available Goals and Objectives column on the left.

3. Click the small square icon at the top-right corner of the screen to **save and exit**.
